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15	(A) A candidate who intends to participate or is participating in a voluntary
16	public campaign finance program that provides vouchers for the purpose of
17	enabling contributions to candidates shall not loan or contribute from his
18	or her own funds an amount that exceeds the Voluntary Self-Funding Limit
19 20	of \$5,000 to their campaign committee or officeholder account, or to any
20	political committee, political party, or any organization that will make an independent expanditure for an against any condidate for a situ elected
21 22	independent expenditure for or against any candidate for a city-elected
22	position within the same election cycle.
23 24	(B) The City Clerk shall over time and at their discretion, present to the City
2 4 25	Council any recommended amendments to this ordinance to modify the
23 26	Voluntary Self-Funding Limit based on experience and on the changes to
27	the Consumer Price Index.
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30	PART 2. City Code Chapter 2-2 (Campaign Finance) is amended to add a new
31	Section 2-2-71 to read:
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33	§ 2-2-71 ADDITIONAL VOUCHER PROGRAM
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35	(A) If the City Code or the City Charter is amended to establish a voluntary
36	public campaign finance program that provides vouchers to registered
37	voters to make contributions to candidates, a separate and additional
38	program, with separate and additional funding, shall be established by this
39	ordinance to provide such vouchers to adults eligible under federal law to
40	donate to a political campaign who are not registered voters. Such persons
41	must have continuously resided in Austin for at least 60 days immediately
42	preceding requesting such a voucher.

44	(B) Any such person opting in to a voucher-based public campaign finance
45	program shall be subject to similar program rules and regulations as
46	voucher recipients in other programs established by the City.
