Petitioner's Texas Driver's License was automatically suspended on the 20th pay of October 2010, as provided by Transportation Code, Section §521.292, for driving while license invalid. Said suspension was for a period of one year.

After examining the pleadings and listening to the evidence and argument of counsel, it is the opinion of the Court that the Petitioner has a valid policy of automobile liability insurance and has an essential need for a Driver's License. The Court further finds that the Attorney for the State is present in Court for hearing on this Petition. The Court further finds that Petitioner has an essential need to operate a motor vehicle for more than four hours a day, and the Court hereby waives the four-hour limitation during any twenty-four hour period.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Petitioner be issued a Driver's License by the Texas Department of Public Safety, allowing her to operate a motor vehicle during the period of his Driver's License Suspension, for the purpose of Essential Need and travel to and from alcohol counseling. This license shall be in effect for the following hours: 7:00 a.m. until 7:00pm, Monday through Friday and 12:00pm until 12:00am on Saturday and Sunday for needs such as employment travel, essential household travel, travel concerning legal matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall keep a driving log available for inspection at all times.

This signed order shall be effective as a driver's license for thirty (30) days. The Petitioner shall be restricted to travel throughout the State of Texas.
