


How democracy vouchers work

Seattle has sent "democracy vouchers" to every voter to spend on city candidate campaigns.





Property owners pay an additional \$30 million in taxes over 10 years, or the City Council appropriates the money from the city's general fund.




Vouchers → Voters

SEEC mails four \$25 youchers to every voter in the city on the first business day of each election year.



Candidates → Candidates

Voters assign the vouchers to candidate campaigns by signing and returning them to candidates or mailing them to the SEEC.

Candidate campaigns spend vouchers up to limits set by the vouchers program.





 - 400 signatures and 400 contributions of \$10+
 - Residents of Seattle, signature verified
- Timeline:
 - ASAP: Vouchers mailed first week of Jan
- Approach:
 - Took to the streets
 - Took assignments
 - Took online and cash donations
- Qualified by March
 - Unique activism/opportunity year?



Return Methods

July 2017 - 11,434 Vouchers

By mail	8117	71%
To Candidate	2956	26%
Misc	361	3%

August 2017 - 6,893 Vouchers

By mail	6042	87%
To Candidate	626	10%
Misc	225	3%

November - 12,495 Vouchers

By mail	11,627	93%
To Candidate	278	2%
Misc	546	4%

- Most residents chose to return their vouchers by mail. 78%
 - Nearly 20% returned vouchers directly to a campaign.
 - 1,949 participants signed campaign forms.

Summary of individual contributors to Council Positions 8 and 9 - 2015 vs 2017

	2015	2017	Increase
City Council Position 8	3,005	12,360	311%
City Council Position 9	1,565	6,795	334%

- Of the 17 candidates running in the three program eligible positions, 13 enrolled in the voucher program. Six of the 13 ultimately qualified for the program.
- After the primary, 5 of the 6 candidates were in the program and had qualified for funding.
- 3 of those candidates had reached their spending limits and could not receive additional voucher funds.

 - who is engaged?








More Contributors and More Small \$ Donors






2017 Seattle Elections Contributors by Type (#) 8-Teresa Mosqueda




