When two days had passed and I had received no response, I forwarded the same e-mail to Interim City Attorney Anne Morgan and asked her to contact Kennard.

It's a given that no public official has to talk to a journalist. But the responses to a journalist's questions are generally either "no comment." Or no response at all.

If I wanted my communication to Kennard to be turned into a Public Information Request, then I would certainly have labeled it as such and would <u>not have asked for a comment but for public records</u>.

Of all the lame responses I have received from the Law Department, this has to rank among the worst of the worst.
