
DO YOU LIVE IN THE "RIGHT" PART OF AUSTIN?

Check this map.



Politically the "right" part of Austin is 4 ZIP codes: 78701, 78703, 78731, 78759.

If you live in those ZIP codes then:

- more than 50% of the City Council Members have lived near you
- 15 of 17 mayors have lived near you

If you don't live in those ZIP codes then:

- you likely don't live near a City Council member
- you very likely don't live near any mayors

Today in Austin politics, where you live decides your influence. For 40 years, more than half of City Council and 15 of 17 mayors lived in the same part of town, home to just 10% of Austinites. Even minority city council members are not elected by minority voters.

THAT'S NOT FAIR!

City Council Members can't fairly represent all of Austin if they all live in only one part of town! Real representation will come when City Council members live where their voters do.

The Proposition 3 plan will give every Austinite a chance to be represented on City Council. Under this plan, every Austinite will live near **THEIR** City Council member.
