


## **News Releases/Media Advisories**

---

- Media Advisories will alert media of specific events we want them to attend and cover in their news stories.
- News Releases are pre-packaged stories that media outlets can copy to their websites, publications or turn into a video/audio story for TV/radio news programming.
  - Both will be published online and distributed through the Community Registry and Austin Notes (see next slides.)

# **News Releases/Media Advisories (continued-Community Registry)**

- For years the City has maintained the Community Registry which is a list of neighborhood associations' leadership and neighborhood groups.
- Neighborhood associations can register to be contacted via this group online.
- We can send any communications regarding charter revision through this group.



## **Community Registry**

The Community Registry database includes boundaries, contacts, meeting schedules, links to related Web sites and other valuable information about community groups, including over 500 Austin neighborhood groups. To search the Community Registry database

- 1 Enter an Organization Name, or ZIP code, in the appropriate box to find your neighborhood association or other organization of interest
- 2 Press the Submit button

Enter all or part of the Organization's Name

Or enter a 5 Digit ZIP code: 78746


OR click on either Search button without entering any text to list ALL organizations in the Community Registry.

### **Notes:**

- 1 The ZIP code field in the current database is based upon each organization's mailing address. Some organizations use a Post Office Box number for their mailing address. In these cases, the mailing address may not be in the same ZIP code as the organization's actual boundaries.
- 2 The U.S. Postal Service offers ZIP code lookup.
- 3 Please contact the City Communications Public Information Office, (512) 974-2220, with any questions or information about registering your organization.
