ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY RECONCILIATION

Corporations Section

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as

incorporator of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1

NAME

The name of the Corporation is the COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY RECONCILATION.

ARTICLE 2

NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The Corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE 3

DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE 4

PURPOSE

- 4.1 The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 4.2 The primary purpose of the Corporation, subject to the limitations herein provided, is to promote and facilitate conciliation, reconciliation, building community and

conflict transformation among and between Austin's (Texas) diverse population; particularly – although not exclusively -- as it relates to race, ethnicity, nationality, and culture. To achieve its purpose, the Corporation will engage in and use all necessary and expedient activities including, but not limited to, training; instruction; speeches; seminars; celebrations; and various vehicles of electronic, verbal and print communication.

4.3 No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Four hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 5

DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE 6

NO MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE 7

AGENT FOR PROCESS

ARTICLE 8


Forfeiture pursuant to Section 171.309 of the Texas Tax Code of COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY RECONCILIATION

File Number: 158363001 Certificate / Charter forfeited: February 13, 2004

The Secretary of State hereby determines and finds the following:

- 1. The Secretary of State received certification from the Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 171.302 of the Texas Tax Code that there are grounds for forfeiture of the charter or certificate of authority of the referenced entity.
- 2. That the entity has not revived its forfeited corporate privileges within 120 days after the date that the corporation privileges were forfeited.
- 3. The Comptroller of Public Accounts has determined that the entity does not have assets from which a judgment for any tax, penalty, or court costs imposed under Chapter 171 of the Code may be satisfied.

It is therefore ordered that charter or certificate of authority of the referenced entity be forfeited without judicial ascertainment and that the proper entry be made upon the permanent files and records of such entity to show such forfeiture as of the date hereof.
