Williamson County Commissioners:

I write on behalf of the Texas Association of Children and Families. I am the organization's Executive Director. I am writing you to state a claim and demand that you or the entity which you represent, the political subdivision of Williamson County, cease and desist from your failure to supervise the Judges, ad litem, amicus attorneys, court appointed counselors and parenting facilitators, other court appointed professionals and court employees in the Williamson County District Court, and pay damages to the families who were harmed by your failure to supervise.

On December 1st, 2015, on behalf of the Association, we delivered to your attention, evidence of the racketeering enterprise operating within Williamson County, both in person and by email. We also appeared before you on January 5th, 2016 and explained that the County's policies were still allowing this enterprise to flourish, damaging countless families for at least a decade. We offered to hand over any and all evidence you might request to support our claims.


We have also had someone contact your office about forming a Domestic Relations Office (DRO) as Travis County and other Texas counties have done in response to similar claims to protect the citizens of their county. You took no action in response to our request other than to publicly discourage families from coming to you for help. You also sent a letter to our organization reiterating your refusal to cooperate.

Our desire is to work with you. Like you, we desire to assist in creating policies to protect families from being extorted by the members of the racketeering enterprise: Sara Naylor, Kelley Baker, Rhonda Hohmann, Sankalpa, LLC, and Rachel Saenger in Williamson County. We therefore demand that you act immediately to cease and desist your failure to supervise these individuals and the individuals responsible for their supervision as you are responsible for doing; that you institute plans for establishing a Domestic Relations Office in Williamson County and apprise us of the schedule for its' launch, and that you compensate the families who were damaged by your incompetent and harmful policies.

As a nonprofit association, our goal is to restore justice to families in the State of Texas. Families in Williamson County need your office's assistance and we would gratefully work with you to assist in administering compensation to the families that were damaged. We will continue to remain available to assist you in making the necessary changes to ensure that no other families are damaged.

We welcome your reply to texaschildrenandfamilies@gmail.com. If you fail to respond by June 1st, 2016, I hope you will understand that we will have no option other than filing a lawsuit to address the preceding issues.
