Personally appeared before me the undersigned Peter D. Kennedy, a person known to me, who, being duly sworn on oath, stated as follows:

- My name is Peter D. Kennedy. I am over the age of 18, and have not been convicted of a felony. The facts contained in this Affidavit are within my personal knowledge and are true and correct.
- 2. I am an attorney and sharcholder with the law firm of Graves, Dougherty, Hearon & Moody, P.C. ("Graves, Dougherty"), counsel for Defendants. This affidavit supplements my affidavit filed December 9, 2014 with documentation of the attorney's fees and expenses incurred after the December 18, 2014 hearing in this matter through today.
- I remain lead counsel with primary responsibility for all aspects of this case. I
 have personal knowledge of all work done from December 19, 2014, through today.
- Court costs. Between December 19, 2014 and today, the Defendants incurred an additional \$16.70 in court costs, as shown in Exhibit A.

- Expenses. Between December 19, 2014 and today, the Defendants incurred an additional \$5.66 in other expenses, as shown in Exhibit A.
- Attorney's fees. Between December 19, 2014 and today, the Defendants consequently incurred an additional \$5,712.00 in reasonable and necessary attorney's fees, as shown in the attached Exhibit A.
- 7. Reasonableness of attorney's fees. It is my opinion that the attorney's fees incurred between December 19, 2014 and today were reasonable and necessary. The general basis for this opinions is stated in Paragraphs 9-12 of my original affidavit. The time additional time spent on this case after the December 18, 2014 was reasonable and necessary to receive, review and analyze the Plaintiff's response to the Motion to Dismiss and the request for discovery; to research, analyze, draft and file the Defendants' Reply in support of their motion to dismiss; and to prepare for and present the merits of the Motion to Dismiss on January 5, 2014.
- 8. The descriptions of of the work performed, time spent, and fees incurred between January 19, 2014 and today are contained in Exhibit A. Exhibit A consists of true and correct copies of records obtained from Graves, Dougherty's billing system. These contemporaneously-kept records contain entries describing my work on this case. These records were made at or near the time of the activity by me, a personal with personal knowledge. These records were kept in the course of a regularly-conducted business activity. It is the regular practice of Graves, Dougherty to keep such records. The amount of time spent and the billing for those tasks was reasonable and necessary. I have carefully reviewed each entry, and I have marked by hand and removed any additional time spent on this litigation that may be considered redundant, unnecessary or not directly related to the defense of the lawsuit. - In the event of a Petition for Review to the Texas Supreme Court filed by the Defendants: an additional \$10,000;
- In the event of a request for a Response to a Petition for Review to the Texas Supreme Court filed by the Plaintiffs: an additional \$10,000;
- In the event of merits briefing in the Texas Supreme Court: an additional \$20,000;
- In the event of oral argument in the Texas Supreme Court: an additional \$10,000.
