RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TRAVIS COUNTY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVIVAL CENTER

I.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 1396-4.06 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (the "Act"), Travis County Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Survival Center, a Texas non-profit corporation subject to the provisions of the Act (the "Corporation"), hereby adopts the Restated Articles of Incorporation attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>.

II.

The Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 26, 2009 by the vote of a majority of the Board of Directors of the Corporation in office.

IIL

The Restated Articles of Incorporation accurately copy the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation and all amendments thereto that are in effect to date. The Restated Articles of Incorporation does not make any new amendments to the Articles of Incorporation being restated.

EXHIBIT A

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TRAVIS COUNTY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVIVAL CENTER

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is Travis County Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Survival Center.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period for its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

Subject to the provisions of Section 2.01 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, the corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for educational, charitable and other purposes permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized include without limitation providing shelter and counseling services and other services to persons who have experienced the effects of domestic violence or sexual assault.

ARTICLE FIVE

The corporation may (but need not) have members, the qualifications, rights and privileges of which shall be as set forth in the corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE SIX

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 1515 A Grove Boulevard, Austin, Texas 78741 and the name of its registered agent at that address is Julia E. Spann.

ARTICLE SEVEN

ARTICLE EIGHT

Any action required by the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act to be taken at any annual or special meeting of the members or directors, or any action which may be taken at any annual or special meeting of the members, directors or of any committee, may be taken without a meeting, if a consent in writing, setting forth the action to be taken, is signed by a sufficient number of members, directors or committee members as would be necessary to take that action at a meeting at which all of the members, directors, or members of the committee were present and voted. Each such written consent shall be executed, dated, and filed with the corporation in the manner required by Article 9.10 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE NINE

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Four hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing and distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE TEN

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the corporation shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), as the corporation shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE ELEVEN

To the fullest extent permitted by law, a director of the corporation is not liable to the corporation or to its members for monetary damages for an act or omission in the director's capacity as a director.
