I represent Mackenzie-Anne Kelly, Austin City Council Member, and Linda Guerrero, candidate for Austin City Council District 9 in the matter of their attached sworn complaints against City of Austin Mayor Steve Adler for violating Tex. Elec. Code section 255.003(a). Please communicate with me as their complaint is processed. The Ethics Commission forms attached have been filed with the Texas Ethics Commission but are provided to the Travis County Attorney's Office for criminal prosecution as a Class A misdemeanor.

I hope you will agree that no public official, Democrat or Republican, friend or foe, should be able to use public resources to endorse or oppose political candidates as Mayor Steve Adler did. If Mayor Adler's example were to become precedent, government officials who have privileged access to TV staff, equipment, and websites could use those public resources for "political advertising" to endorse or oppose political candidates in violation of laws intended to prevent such misuse of public resources.
