Mr. Woodby—I recognize that Ms. Vahl, having received a settlement proposal from me, is ethically bound to present it to her clients. For several years I worked at the Texas Attorney General's office and am aware that the process takes time. Yet, given the history of this litigation, Plaintiffs have little hope that our offer will be accepted. We are not enthusiastic about further delays in litigation that has been continuing for years now.

Ms. Vahl requests that the Court “not enter an order before 12/1.” I suggest that if the parties haven't informed the Court that settlement has been achieved by 12:00 noon on Friday, December 1, it would be appropriate for the Court to enter the Order that afternoon, or as soon thereafter as practicable.
